“Crossing the Street Safely”

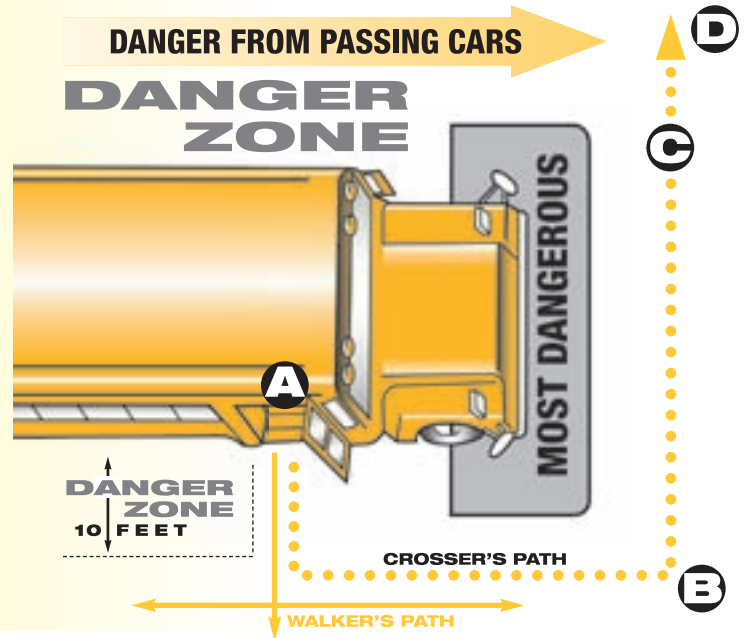
Here are the four most important steps to getting on and off the bus and crossing the street safely.

A. The driver will let you off when traffic has stopped. Wait until you are told it is safe to cross. Look to the left and right when you get off the bus.

B. Walk forward along the side of the road to a point 10 feet in front of the bus. Make sure that the bus driver sees you.

C. After the driver signals you to cross, stay protected by the bus and look both ways to make sure no cars are coming from either direction. Do not cross if cars are still coming towards you.

D. When you are sure that all vehicles have stopped and the way is clear, carefully walk across the street.

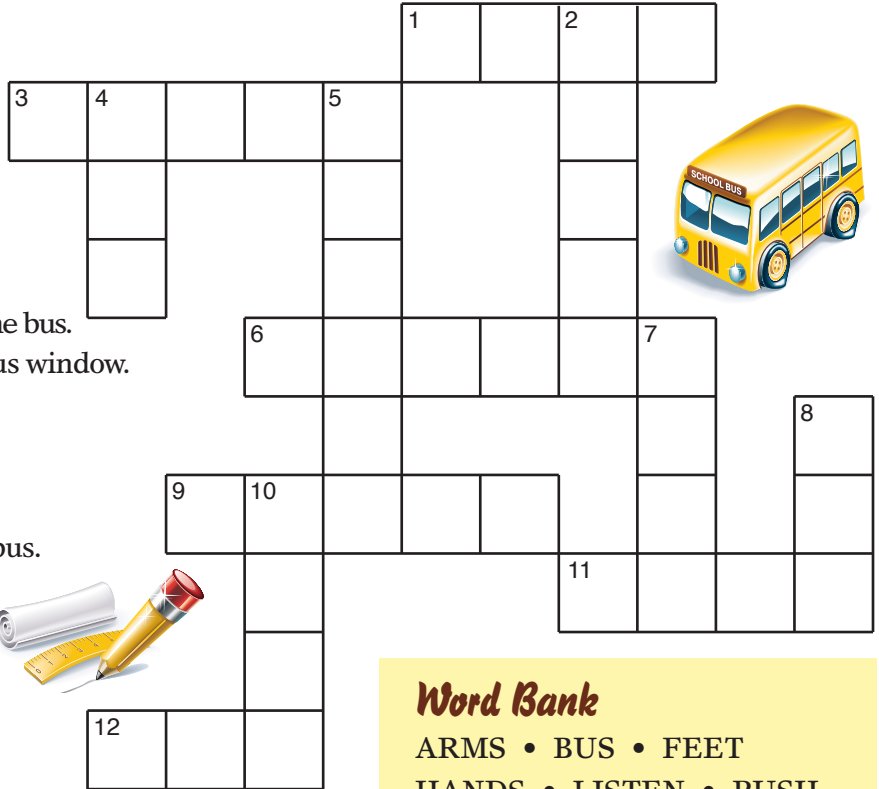

Did you know...

- When a bus stops on a 2 lane roadway to pick-up or drop off students, all lanes of traffic must stop.
- State law requires all school buses to stop at railroad crossings and prohibits a school bus from making a right on red.
- Most school bus accidents occur when motorists try to “beat the bus”.
