

<u>ELECTRIC</u> <u>BUS</u> <u>PRESS</u> <u>RELEASE</u>: Suffolk Transportation Service, Inc. has had a long-time commitment to sustainable operations. We received a grant from the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Office of Transportation and Air Quality for more than \$1 million to purchase seven state-of-the-

art electric buses. This funding will enable STS and the Bay Shore School District to expand their CLEAN BUSES initiative, launched in 2018, to include the neighboring school districts of Brentwood and Central Islip. The announcement was made on May 11 at a press conference. In attendance from the three participating school districts, along with STS, were Superintendent of the Central Islip UFSD, Sharon A. Dungee; Superintendent of the Brentwood UFSD, Richard Loeschner; Superintendent of the Bay Shore UFSD, Joseph Bond; and Town of Islip Supervisor, Angie Carpenter.
