**STOP ARM CAMERAS**: Every day 2.3 million children are transported by school buses throughout New York





State. Data has shown that on a single school day, an estimated 50,000 drivers throughout the State illegally pass stopped school buses. The **School Bus Stop-Arm Safety Program** outfits Suffolk County's school bus fleets with the latest stop-arm safety technology. When a school bus is

stopped and its lights and stop-arm are activated, stop-arm cameras capture vehicles illegally passing the bus. A first-time stop-arm violation carries a fine of \$250. Additionally, subsequent violations within an eighteenmonth period are subject to a \$25 increase in penalty, up to a maximum of \$300. If an employee of STS/SBC in a company vehicle is captured, the fines are paid by the employee, just like red light camera violations. Remember...when a school bus stops and flashes its red lights, traffic approaching from either direction must stop before reaching the bus: on a two-lane road, on multi-lane highways and on divided highways. Yellow flashing lights mean the bus is preparing to stop to load or unload children. Slow down and prepare to stop your vehicle. Red flashing lights mean the bus has stopped and children are getting on or off. Stop your vehicle and wait until the school bus resumes motion or until signaled by the driver or police officer to proceed.
