

MAKING LEFT-HAND TURNS: How many left turns do you make throughout the day? Making a left turn is one of the more dangerous moves drivers have to make on the road. Consider this: the U.S. Department of Transportation reports that across the country, over 53% of "crossing-path crashes" involve left-hand turns and a study by New York City Transportation revealed that left turns were 3x more likely to cause a deadly crash involving a pedestrian. The reasons behind these disturbing

statistics are varied but several are pretty obvious:

- Left turns disrupt the flow of traffic—in both directions if there isn't a left turn lane and traffic signal.
- Drivers have to gauge the speed and the distance of the oncoming vehicles...and THEN safely cross the
  opposite lane while also watching for pedestrians and bicyclists.
- There's an increasing propensity for drivers NOT to use their directional blinkers so other drivers don't know their intentions.

Make sure your left-hand turns are safe!
