ESSENTIAL WORKERS!

ESSENTIAL WORKFORCE: All employees of STS & SBC are considered essential workers. We have a responsibility to get folks where they need to go safely. Whether it is getting someone to work or school the general public depends on us. Whether you drive the bus, assist the students, change the oil, or support those that do to these jobs, we all have an important role to play in keeping ourselves safe. Please continue

to keep your social circles small and wear a mask. Let's work together to keep ourselves, our families, our coworkers and our passengers safe.

NEW CDC GUIDELINES FOR QUARANTINE: On Monday, December 27, the CDC issued new guidance regarding quarantine and isolation. Quarantine has been reduced to 5 days instead of 10 days for both vaccinated and non-vaccinated employees. **The Company will follow the CDC guidelines.**

If you Test Positive: Whether you are **Fully Vaccinated or Not Vaccinated**, you must isolate for 5 days. You can return to work on day 6 if you have no fever for 72 hours without the use of fever reducing medications, and no other symptoms. You must follow strict mask use upon return to work.

If you are Exposed and Fully Vaccinated: You do not have to quarantine after close contact with a COVID positive person unless you have symptoms. Test on day 5, if possible, even if you don't have symptoms.

If you are Exposed and Not Vaccinated: You must quarantine after close contact with an COVID positive person for 5 days. Test on day 5, if possible, even if you don't have symptoms.

Close Contact is defined as being within 6ft. of a positive COVID person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more within a 24-hour period, even if masked.

The CDC further recommends that any person who returns from quarantine after five days should continue to wear a mask around other persons for five additional days. Our Company mask policy is still in effect. All employees must wear a mask in company buildings and on company buses and vehicles.

COVID TESTING: We will resume our weekly testing schedule beginning next week. Vaccinated employees are welcome to take a 'peace of mind test' and avoid the long lines. Family Members are welcome at the Harold Court and Pond Road locations only.
