<u>STOP SIGNS</u>: Stop signs mean stop. At every Stop sign your bus should stop all forward motion. Your wheels must come to a full stop. Look to see if you have a clear vision of the intersection. Look Left, Right, and Left again before you proceed into the intersection. If you do not have a clear vision, move forward to get a clear vision and look Left, Right, Left again. Do not become complacent at Stop signs. Rolling stops at a Stop sign are the leading cause of accidents.
