Company policy states: before and after each and every time you move your vehicle, you must check the entire vehicle for sleeping/unattended children, especially, without limitation, under every seat. Make sure no child is left on your vehicle and is discharged to an authorized adult - parent, guardian, school or facility personnel - at drop off. This is a zero-tolerance policy.
