As she approached a second red light, she was forced to stop and as she entered the intersection, she opened the door and rolled into the intersection, ejecting herself from the car, leaving behind her pocketbook with her cell phone. She ran to a convenience store and called 911. We provided the victim a "new" cell phone that was donated to us through your generosity to the Cell Phone Bank. Thank you for all your support and assistance. Once again, a victim is safer for having access to a cell phone".
