Whether you've changed banks, updated account numbers, or just want to double-check, it's a quick and easy way to ensure your pay goes exactly where it should. **Log into DayForce → Navigate to "My Profile" → Select "Direct Deposit" → Review and update as needed.**

SCHOOL BUS UNIFORM POLICY REMINDER. As a trusted transportation provider, maintaining a professional appearance is essential to the safety and confidence of the students and families we serve. Uniform compliance not only reflects our high standards but also supports our security protocols in line with Homeland Security and TSA guidelines.

Waist Up

- **ID Badge:** Must be visible on your outermost layer.
- **Uniform Shirt:** STS shirts (long or short sleeve) must be buttoned. Only white, blue, grey, or black t-shirts underneath.
- **Reflective Gear:** Jackets/vests must have reflective stripes and be worn over an STS shirt. No hoods while driving.
- **Hats:** Only STS-issued hats are allowed.

Waist Down

- **Bottoms:** Neat, solid-colored pants, jeans, shorts (max 1" above knee), or skirts (knee-length or longer). Colors: blue, black, brown, khaki.
- **Not Allowed:** Spandex, sweatpants, sweat shorts.
- **Footwear:** Closed-toe and closed-back shoes only. No flip-flops or Croc-style shoes.
