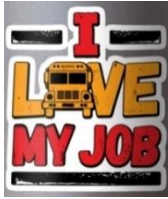

Transit Sensitivity Classes – Schedule & Registration

Info The schedule for Transit Sensitivity Classes is now available on **My Parking Space** under the **Classes > Upcoming Classes** section, all Transit and Para-Transit drivers are required to register for a class. These sessions fill up fast, so be sure to sign up early to secure your spot! Classes begin promptly at 7:00 AM, so please arrive at least 30 minutes early to sign in and find a seat. You'll receive the new Safety Manual during the session, and we encourage you to bring your old manual for recycling.

NYSED 30-Hour Driver Basic course. If you haven't yet attended the NYSED 30-Hour Driver Basic Course, you should have received a letter with the upcoming class dates and times. This course is a New York State requirement for all school bus drivers and must be completed within your first year of service. To comply with the requirements, individuals are expected to attend all scheduled classes as indicated in their notification and register through My Parking Space. Football Season Is Here... But Tailgating Is Still a No-Go (on the road)! We get it football season brings out the excitement, but let's keep tailgating to the parking lot, not behind the wheel! Almost 10% of accidents happen because drivers follow too closely. And no, "they stopped short!" isn't a free pass. As professional drivers, you've got the skills to keep it safe and smooth.

Here's the play: follow the 4-second rule for buses (2 seconds for personal vehicles). Pick a marker (like a signpost), watch the car ahead pass it, and count "one thousand one, one thousand two..." until you pass it. If you get there before 4 seconds, you're too close—ease up and try again.

Let's keep the touchdowns on the field and the bumpers off each other. Drive smart, drive safe, and enjoy the season (from a safe distance)!
