Summer Work Sign Up is in Full Swing! Drivers and driver assistants who wish to work over the summer must sign up on My Parking Space (MPS) now until May 15, 2026. Employees who sign up will select their summer routes in seniority order, with pick dates and times to be announced. After sign-ups close, remaining routes will be offered to employees who did not sign up, in reverse seniority order. Drivers or driver assistants who refuse an available route or fail to appear for their scheduled pick will be required to acknowledge forfeiture of unemployment benefits for the summer. If the number of employees who sign up exceeds the amount of available summer work, less senior employees may not be assigned summer routes.
